

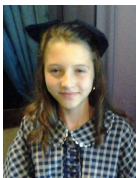

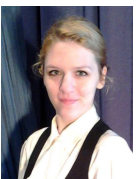
MEET ACT XIV

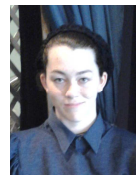


Lillie Bruce plays the part of Jo. She's a 13-year-old and is in the eighth grade. This is her 6th play with ACT. She says she hopes to do more.
